SCALPEL CUTS - UNDERSTANDING THE RISKS AND HOW TO PREVENT THEM

A study of Sharps Injury cases reported by a university hospital showed that the annual incidence of sharps injuries was 8.19% among all dental workers. Those with less experience had a higher percentage of incidences at 21.28% per year*.

A total of 56 injuries were reported by the university. In 16 of the 56 cases, the injury was caused by cutting instruments, such as periodontal curettes, surgical scalpels, and scissors
